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Juneyao Group partners with Lufthansa Technik for Engine Maintenance Services

- **First long-term partnership with Juneyao Group for CFM56 overhaul services**
- **Largest exclusive engine maintenance services agreement in Lufthansa Technik's history in China**

This new partnership builds upon more than a decade of successful collaboration between Lufthansa Technik and Juneyao Group across multiple service areas, including Single Component Maintenance and Mobile Engine Services. With the latest agreement, the cooperation now extends into full engine overhaul support.
